### Water Rights: Oppose

- AB 460 (Bauer-Kahan) State Water Resources Control Board: water rights and usage: interim relief: procedures.
- AB 1337 (Wicks) State Water Resources Control Board: water diversion curtailment.

## Metropolitan Support if Amended

- AB 2060 (Soria): Lake and streambed alteration agreements: exemptions
- SB 1390 (Caballero): Groundwater recharge: floodflows: diversion

- AB 903 (Skinner) Environmental health: product safety: perfluoroalkyl and polyfluoroalkyl substances
- AB 2409 (Papan) Office of Planning and Research: permitting accountability transparency dashboard
- AB 2610 (Garcia) Protected species: authorized take: Salton Sea Management Program: System Conservation Implementation Agreement

## Prop 218 Clean-Up: Support

- AB 1827 (Papan): Local government: fees and charges: water: higher-consumptive water parcels
- AB 2257 (Wilson): Local government: property-related water and sewer fees and assessments: remedies
- SB 1072 (Padilla): Local government: Proposition 218: remedies.
