Sites Reservoir Water Rights Application

- Protest period ended August 31st, 2023 with 15 total protests received
- Next steps: Sites is working with protestants to find resolution. Unresolved protests will go to hearing

State Water Contractors Protest

- Supportive of the proposed Sites Reservoir Project
- Existing SWP and future Delta Conveyance Project water rights could be impacted
- Protest process provides a forum for ensuring that the water rights of all parties are protected

Equitable Stewardship of California's Water in a Changing Climate



- <u>Grant:</u> \$8.2 million California Climate Action grant awarded to UC Berkeley
- <u>Deliverables</u>: flexible and accessible version of water operations model used by state & federal agencies for water planning in California
- Overarching goal: advance underlying science, identify needs for improving existing models and build a foundation for collaborative decision making to advance equitable, sustainable and climate-resilient water stewardship in California
- <u>**Community partners:**</u> Tribal communities, TNC, Restore the Delta, DSC, PPIC, State and Federal agencies, and others
