WaterWise Consulting, Inc. currently supports the following Metropolitan Conservation Programs:

- The Regional Pre-1994 Toilet Replacement Program, and
- Pre- and post-inspections for member agency-administered commercial turf replacement programs.

Changes to Inspection Activity


Anticipating an increase in commercial and public agency turf replacement applications

- An increase in funding for turf replacement from U.S.
 Bureau of Reclamation Lower Colorado River Basin
 System Conservation and Efficiency Program
- Agencies addressing non-functional turf



Proposed Agreement for Inspection and Verification Services • Staff proposes to enter a three-year solesource agreement for an amount not to exceed \$4,500,000 to provide inspection and verification services for Metropolitan's conservation programs

Board Options for Metropolitan's Inspection Program

Option #1

Authorize the General Manager to enter into a new three-year sole source agreement with WaterWise Consulting, Inc. for inspection and verification services for Metropolitan's Conservation Programs, for a total agreement not to exceed \$4,500,000

Option #2

Authorize the General Manager to authorize a new eighteenmonth sole-source agreement with WaterWise Consulting, Inc. for inspection and verification services for Metropolitan's Conservation Programs, for a total agreement not to exceed \$400,000

Option #3

Do not authorize a new agreement with WaterWise Consulting, Inc. If not authorized, the program will end
