April 14, 2026

54426 The Board of Directors of The Metropolitan Water District of Southern California met on Tuesday, April 14, 2026.

Chair Ortega called the teleconference meeting to order at 1:02 p.m.

54427 The Meeting was opened with an invocation by Board Vice Chair Juan Garza, Central Basin Municipal Water District.

54428 The Pledge of Allegiance was given by Board Secretary Lois Fong-Sakai.

54429 Board Secretary Fong-Sakai administered the roll call. Those responding present were: Directors Ackerman, Alvarez, Bryant, Camacho, Cordero, Crane, Crawford, De Jesus, Denham, Dennstedt, Douglas, Erdman, Faessel, Fellow, Fong-Sakai, Garza, Gold, Jay, Jung, Katz, Kurtz, Lewitt, McCoy, McMillan, Miller, Ortega, Paule, Pressman, Quinn, Ramos, Seckel, and Sutley.

Those not responding were: Directors Gray, Petersen, Phan, and Shepherd Romey.

Board Secretary Fong-Sakai declared a quorum present.

Director(s) entered after roll call: Kassakhian.

Chair Ortega announced we would be reordering the agenda, as we have a special guest speaker today, former Congresswoman Grace Napolitano, to speak on the completion of the removal of radioactive uranium tailings remedial action project celebration on April 9th in Moab, Utah.

Former Congresswoman Napolitano and Chair Ortega spoke on the history and celebration event in Utah.

Chair Ortega announced that we will consider board item 8-1 first.

- 54430** a. Approved the FY 2026/27 and FY 2027/28 Biennial Budget, which includes:
- (i) appropriation of \$3,619.9 million for Metropolitan operations and maintenance and operating equipment, power costs on the CRA, SWC operations, maintenance, power and replacement costs and SWC capital charges, demand management programs including the LRP agreements and conservation programs, and costs associated with supply programs for FYs 2026/27 and 2027/28 (shown in Table 4);

- (ii) a continuing appropriation of \$740.9 million for FYs 2026/27 and 2027/28 for debt service on Metropolitan general obligation and revenue bonds (Table 4);
- (iii) continued appropriation of \$98.4 million for AVEK participation rights for FYs 2026/27 and 2027/28 via debt issued in 2025 by AVEFA on behalf of Metropolitan as obligator (Table 4);
- (iv) appropriation of \$1,025 million funding for CIP for FYs 2026/27 and 2027/28; and,
- (v) appropriation of \$150 million funding for 45-MGD Stage 1 PWSC planning and final design costs for FYs 2026/27 & 2027/28;
- b. Authorized the use of approximately \$75.9 million of available SWRCB fund, received Large Scale Water Recycling Plant (LSWRP) Grants reimbursements and future reimbursements to fund the PWSC planning and design costs and authorize a one-time draw from unrestricted reserves in fiscal year 2027/28 not to exceed \$58 million and appropriate for PWSC final design and if the unrestricted reserves fall below the minimum then the item will return to the Board;
- c. Authorized the use of \$385.0 million in operating revenues to fund the CIP for FYs 2026/27 and 2027/28;
- d. Approved total revenue requirements to be paid from rates and charges of \$1,542.8 million in FY 2026/27 and \$1,672.7 million in FY 2027/28;
- e. Approved the Ten-Year Financial Forecast, as summarized in Figure 1;
- f. Approved water rates and charges effective January 1, 2027, and January 1, 2028, as shown in Table 5, which result in an overall increase of 6.2 percent in CY 2027 and 6.2 percent in CY 2028 from CY 2026 rates and charges;
- g. Adopted the Resolution Fixing and Adopting Water Rates To Be Effective January 1, 2027, and 2028, in the form of **Attachment 5**;
- h. Adopted the Resolution Fixing and Adopting a Readiness-To-Serve Charge Effective January 1, 2027, in the form of **Attachment 6**;
- i. Adopted the Resolution Fixing and Adopting a Capacity Charge Effective January 1, 2027, in the form of **Attachment 7**;
- j. Adopted the Resolution Fixing and Adopting the Treatment Fixed Charges Effective January 1, 2027, in the form of **Attachment 8**; and,
- k. Directed staff to evaluate the Conservation Program and the Local Resources Program within the next year to prioritize programs that are cost-effective and that meet the needs of Metropolitan and its member agencies.
- l. In addition, authorized additional appropriation of approximately \$16 million for PWSC final design from federal grant sources for a total appropriation of \$150 million over the two-year budget;
- m. The project will undergo the CAMP4W evaluation and treatment studies process by year-end to assist the Board in its implementation decision; and
- n. Directed staff to conduct a market study for the sale of two islands and bring back that study to the Board for review. (**Board Item 8-1**)

Director Miller moved, seconded by Director Pressman, that the Board approve the Board Item 8-1.

Chair Ortega declared a recess.

54431 Chair Ortega invited members of the public to address the Board on matters within the Board's jurisdiction (in-person and via teleconference).

Chair Ortega addressed the following: Other Matters and Reports.

54432 Chair Ortega asked if there were any corrections to the report of events attended by Directors at Metropolitan's expense during the month of March, as previously posted and distributed to the Board. None were made.

54433 Chair Ortega referred to the Chair's monthly report, which was previously posted and distributed to the Board. In addition, ceremonies were held at the San Diego County Water Authority regarding the water exchange, the board leadership visits to the Central Arizona aqueduct, and the Desert facilities. Metropolitan is celebrating Earth Week from April 19 through April 25th, Administrative Professionals Day on April 22nd, Armenian History Month, and the release of the climate action plan progress report. Chair Ortega asked if there were any questions or comments to the report. None were made.

54434 General Manager Deshmukh thanks former Congresswoman Grace Napolitano for visiting Metropolitan and her leadership. In addition, update on the Colorado River Tours, Imperial Irrigation District visit, Earth Day and Administrative Professionals celebrations, upcoming Cannon Michael, Northern California Water Association joining the Executive Committee, and the upcoming vote on the next year's fiscal budget.

Chair Ortega announced during the May committee meetings that the General Manager will present a vision for Metropolitan and a report on his first 100 days.

54435 General Counsel Scully, in addition to her written report, reported as part of her business plan her office assists the board and general manager in implementing their priorities. She highlighted Patty Quilizapa's work on the budget and rates and thanked her legal staff, Patty Quilizapa and Betty Kuo Brinton, for their work on the budget adoption and for ensuring the motions are presented clearly for the board vote.

54436 General Auditor Suzuki stated he has nothing to add to his written report.

54437 Ethics Officer Salinas, in addition to his written report, announced that Metropolitan is being recognized with the Certificate of Transparency of Excellence. Chris Palmer, Senior Public Affairs Field Coordinator with California Special Districts Association, presented Mr. Salinas with the certificate.

Chair Ortega announced the board will take the vote on Item 8-1. Committee Chair Miller read the motion into the record and moved the motion, and Board Vice Chair Pressman seconded the motion.


