Turf Replacement Rebates:

May: 719,451 ft² replaced

FY2024/25-FY2025/26: 5,932,372 ft² replaced



Trees (part of Turf Replacement Program):

May: 232 trees rebated

FY2024/25-FY2025/26: 1,916 units rebated



Toilets:

May: 1,108 units rebated

FY2024/25-FY2025/26: 14,575 units rebated

Lifetime Water Savings to be achieved by all rebates in May 2025: 2,303 AF

FY2024/25-FY2025/26: 40,101 AF lifetime water savings
