MyWarehouse Shopping Cart Replacement

Background

- MyWarehouse (existing) allows Metropolitan field staff to order work equipment from the inventory to be fulfilled by warehouse staff.
- Existing application 10 years old, no support available
- Does not support mobile devices
- Does not integrate with Oracle EBS Requires manual inventory synchronization
 - Difficult for warehouse staff to keep up
 - Prone to human error

MyWarehouse Shopping Cart Replacement

Scope for New Application

- Custom-developed software will automatically synchronize with the Oracle EBS inventory
- Will be mobile-enabled
- To be built on Oracle's APEX platform
 - Metropolitan staff have experience with and knowledge of the APEX platform
