DWR 2022 Urban Community Drought Relief Grant Application

- Submitted applications to DWR in January 2023
 - Increase incentive for Non-functional Turf
 Replacement (\$30 million for CII and public agencies)
 - Residential Devices Direct Install Program
 (\$5 million for customers in both MWD and SoCalGas service area)
 - Firefighter Training Recirculation Units (\$3 million for fire departments through Water Savings Incentive Program)
- Board resolutions needed to support applications

Board Options
