# Adopt a Resolution to Designate Signatories

### Subject

Adopt a resolution designating authorized agents for funding from the Federal Emergency Management Agency and the California Office of Emergency Services; the General Manager has determined that the proposed action is exempt or otherwise not subject to CEQA

#### Purpose

Cal OES and FEMA require disaster assistance applicants to submit board-approved Designation of Applicant's Agent Resolution for Non-State Agencies (Resolution), every three years, or any time a change is requested

## Cal OES and FEMA Grant Funding

### Background

- Metropolitan is eligible for State and Federal disaster relief funding
- Prior to awards due to damage from wildfire and storm events
- "Applicants Agent Resolution for Non-State Agencies" requires designation of signatory
  - Three-year duration
- Previous resolution authorized in December 2022

### Cal OES and FEMA Grant Funding

### Summary

- Receipt of grant funds requires that the Board designate signatories to receive disaster relief funds
- This action authorizes a resolution designating signatory agents for all FEMA and Cal OES grants
- This resolution allows Metropolitan to received grant funding and pursue future disaster relief assistance
- Without this resolution, Metropolitan would need to self-fund emergency recovery from O&M resources, potentially reducing the funds available for other scheduled O&M projects

### Cal OES and FEMA Grant Funding

#### Resolution

- Authorizes a resolution designating signatory agents for all Cal OES and FEMA grants
- Metropolitan Board of Directors will authorize the following signatory agents:
  - Assistant General Manager, Water and Technical Resources
  - Group Manager, Safety, Security and Protection Officer
  - Group Manager, Engineering Services
- Signatory agents can approve actions for open and future grants for a period of 3 years

### **Board Options**

- Option #1
  - Adopt a resolution designating authorized agents for funding from the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) and the California Office of Emergency Services (Cal OES).
- Option #2
  - Do not approve this resolution.
