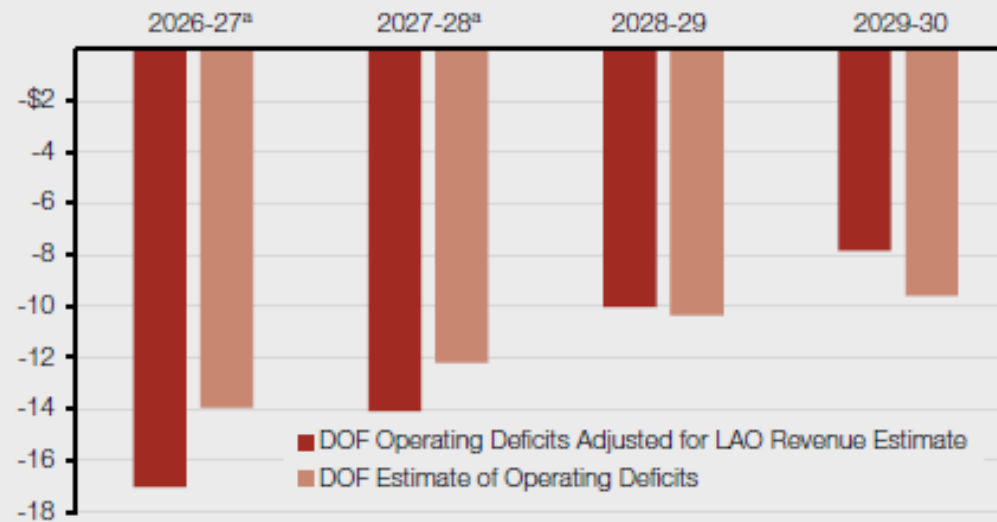
CALIFORNIA **2026-27 BUDGET** *May Revise*

- AB 35 (Alvarez) Safe Drinking Water, Wildfire Prevention, Drought Preparedness, and Clean Air Bond Act of 2024: Administrative Procedure Act: exemption: program guidelines and selection criteria – SUPPORT
- AB 2215 (Calderon) Water rights: permits: State Water Project – SUPPORT
- SB 872 (McNerney) Climate change: funding priorities – SUPPORT

- AB 2739 (Soria) Community Water Affordability Program – SUPPORT
- SB 1125 (Menjivar) Water Rate Assistance Program – SUPPORT

- SB 952 (Laird) State Water Project: renewable energy resources and zero-carbon resources – SUPPORT
