Purpose

Provides incentives for Metropolitan's member agencies to develop new local projects to increase water supply reliability in the region

Current Incentive Payment Structures

Payment Structure Alternatives	Maximum* Incentive Amount	Payment Period
1 – Sliding Scale	\$340/AF	25 years
2 – Sliding Scale**	\$475/AF	15 years
3 – Fixed Incentive Rate	\$305/AF	25 years





Description

- Treatment and conveyance of recovered groundwater
- New project facilities:
 - New Centralized Groundwater Treatment Facility
 - 12,300 linear feet of raw water conveyance pipeline
 - 6 wells & 16 monitoring wells
- Anticipated start of operation: 2025








Doheny Ocean Desalination Project

Doheny Ocean Desalination Project

Description

- Treatment and conveyance of desalinated water
- New project facilities:
 - New Desalination Facility
 - Raw water conveyance and pumping
 - Sub-surface slant intake wells
 - Renewable energy and power facilities
 - Brine and solids disposal
- Anticipated start of operation: 2028



Doheny Ocean Desalination Project

Agreement Terms



5,600 AFY over 25 years

Sliding scale incentives up to \$475/AF for 15 years



\$39.9 million maximum lifetime contract payment

140,000 AF maximum contract yield over 25 years

- Production targets every four years



- Treatment and conveyance of purified recycled water
- New project facilities:
 - New Advanced Water Purification Facility
 - Reverse Osmosis Concentrate line
 - Supporting Facilities
 - Hansen Spreading Grounds improvements
- Anticipated start of operation: 2028

487,500 AF maximum contract yield over 25 years



Sliding scale incentives up to \$475/AF for 15 years

\$139 million maximum lifetime contract payment
