






Business Continuity Plan vs. Other Plans

Business Impact Analysis (BIA)

Operational Impacts

- ✓ Water delivery
- ✓ Water quality
- ✓ Life safety and public health
- ✓ Customer confidence
- ✓ Employee morale
- ✓ Negative publicity

Financial Impacts

- ✓ Loss of revenue
- ✓ Legal/regulatory fines or penalties
- ✓ Loss of government funding
- ✓ Compliance deadlines

Process Recovery Time Objective (RTO) = Shortest impact time (≤ 30 days)

Program Snapshot

- 30+ Business Continuity plans
- 112+ critical business processes (≤ 30 days)
- Fusion Risk Management system used to maintain data and plans
- SharePoint site serves as central repository for plan access
- Administration of the MetAlert emergency notification system
