Background

Project Approval and CEQA Actions Dec. 21, 2023

- DWR certified the Final EIR
- Adopted CEQA findings, a statement of overriding considerations and a Mitigation Monitoring and Reporting Program
- Approved the DCP (Alt 5)
- Filed a Notice of Determination → 30-day statute of limitations

- CEQA
- Delta Reform Act
- Public Trust Doctrine
- Delta and Watershed Protection Acts
- Fully Protected Species Statute (Birds)
- Prop. 9
 - 1982 referendum on Peripheral Canal
- Central Valley Project Act
 - Exceeds DWR's authority to modify the SWP
