Safety and Environmental Program Quarterly Update

Executive Summary

The Safety, Regulatory, and Training Section in the Office of Safety, Security, and Protection oversees Metropolitan's compliance with environmental, health, and safety (EHS) regulations and procedures. This report provides an update on Metropolitan's Safety and Environmental program activities from April 1, 2026, to June 30, 2026.

The next Safety and Environmental Program Quarterly Update will be provided in October 2026.

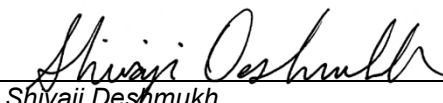
Details and Background

This quarterly report provides an update on the following key areas:

- **Injury Data:** Metropolitan's year-to-date recordable injuries have been compiled, and the current Incident Rate continues to be below the California and Federal Industry rates.
- **Metrics:** There were 245 Safety Review Requests received since the rollout of the E-Forms. Additionally, the EHS Key Performance Indicators show the goal of at least 90 percent completion for Safety Training, Inspections, Toolboxes, and Safety Committees is being met.
- **Regulatory Inspections:** There was one new Cal/OSHA inspection this period at the Foothill Hydroelectric Plant. The Diemer Cal/OSHA inspection appeal has been settled, while the Hinds and Weymouth appeals remain pending. Additionally, there were eight new environmental compliance inspections for this quarter.
- **Communications:** Highlights new Safety Talk, Advisory, and Newsletters are provided.
- **Safety Committee Activities:** Safety Committee Forum and Executive Safety Committee highlights, June Safety Month celebrations, Safety Awards, and Employee Recognition Program are provided.
