Presented by: Elise Goldman, Team Manager – Water Efficiency

Ms. Goldman provided an update on enhancements to the Water Savings Incentive Program (WSIP) to improve participation by agricultural users within Metropolitan's services area. The changes expand incentives for converting water-intensive crops to more water-efficient crops by estimating water savings over a 30-year project life instead of the standard 10 years. The modifications were developed with input from the Conservation Program Advisory Committee and approved by management.
