Legislative Calendar

- February 18 bill introduction deadline
- April 7 18 Spring recess
- April 29 last day for policy committees to hear and pass fiscal bills to fiscal committees
- May 6 last day for policy committees to hear and report nonfiscal bills to the floor
- May 23-27 Floor session only

2022-23 Proposed Budget

- \$286.5 B proposed spending plan
 - \$213.1 B General Fund
- \$45.7 billion projected budget surplus
 - \$20.6 million discretionary
- Priorities:
 - Fighting COVID
 - Combatting climate change
 - Confronting homelessness
 - Tackling cost of living
 - Keeping our streets safe



Drought & Water Resilience Highlights, 2022-23

- \$1.63 B (\$880 M promised 2021-22 and \$750 M new) for:
 - Urban and small community conservation
 - Groundwater clean up and recycling
 - PFAS contamination assistance
 - Conveyance repairs
 - SGMA implementation
 - Immediate drought response
