

Use of Water Conservation Rate Structures


Southern California Shifted Towards Inclining Block Rates and Water Budgets


Southern California Shifted Towards Inclining Block Rates and Water Budgets



AWWA California-Nevada Rates Survey (2020); 120 utilities in MWD service area responded


Residential & CII Turf Replacement (million square feet, sf)

Historical Turf Replacement




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Turf Replacement Activity is Increasing
