




### Sierra Snowpack (March vs. April 2023)




State Water Project (SWP) Conditions

#### SWP Table A Allocation Increases to 100%

#### SWP Conditions

#### SWP Allocation & Article 21

- SWP Allocation increased from 75% to 100%
  - Near record-breaking snowpack throughout Sierra Nevada
  - Spring runoff helping reservoirs reach capacity
    - Lake Oroville Reservoir expected to fill by end of May
- SWP share of San Luis Reservoir currently full
  - Metropolitan share of Article 21 deliveries: ~134 TAF







#### Metropolitan Projecting to Refill Storage Accounts End-of-Year Balances




